

Social Justice Council Policy

Intent

The Board's intent is to establish a Social Justice Council that will review, evaluate, and endorse social justice issues.

Boundaries

The congregation shall not endorse or take a stand on political candidates or partisan issues. Endorsements will be reserved for issues where our endorsement will make a meaningful impact. No endorsements shall be made that will jeopardize the Congregation's non-profit status.

Responsibilities

A board-appointed designee will assemble a council of three UUCU members which will develop procedures for soliciting feedback on issues from the congregation and determine which issues will be endorsed.

The Board of Trustees shall be informed of all endorsements made by the Social Justice Council as they are made.
