Dear Members and Friends,

This year, as we head into the future, our Congregation calls to all of us to embrace our mission, advance our vision for our Congregation and our community, and answer the call of stewardship.

Opportunity beckons and the future is bright. Our stewardship campaign theme, "Sailing into 2021" reflects our optimism for UUCC and our capacity to "keep on course."

- Intersectional Justice Engage members in justice work to achieve a more equitable, inclusive and resilient community.

Our goal this year is to raise \$475,000, as we explore new horizons in justice and community service while continuing to build fellowship within our congregation and our communities. These funds will support the needed programs, staff, and facilities. As a point of reference, last year's stewardship campaign generated \$442,000 in pledges.

We encourage all of our members to be as generous as their means allow in making their stewardship commitment for 2021/22. We are asking that all who can consider pledging at the Sustainer level -- \$5,000 for couples, and \$3,500 for an individual. The enclosed brochure may be helpful in your consideration of your pledge amount.

Your pledge card is enclosed. Please return it promptly so that the Board can plan and present a budget to the congregation in May that is based on our collective commitment. You can also make your pledge online – details are on the pledge card.

Please answer the call to stewardship, service and fellowship. Contribute time, talent and treasure to support the collective endeavors of our congregation and our mission to build community, deepen spirituality and promote justice! With you on board, we will indeed have a bon voyage *Sailing into 2021*.
