- Four items:
 - Line 3107 Killam Scholarship Income Fund moving into undesignated funds
 - Leave \$25,000 in the fund
 - This line item is not the fund for hiring Killam fellows but rather is the income from that fund that has been generated
 - Line 3175 Milliard K Bikel Fund changing its unknown restriction to designating it for social justice
 - Line 3388 Wotan Endowment \$255 fund restricted for undefined purposes moving into line 3304
 - Funds from Lancashire Building, create a Board Designated Fund from these monies. Eye toward long term B&G usage regardless of where the congregation is located.
 - Some amount to be set aside from the fund to fund needed repairs.
