As we begin our 2022-2023 Stewardship Campaign, **Cultivating Our Future**, we ask: How is UUCC doing right now? What does UUCC stand for?



The three banners hanging proudly in the front of our building on Shaker Boulevard, proclaim our values and vision, announcing our commitment to anti-racism, diversity, individual identity, and environmental stewardship.

We are pleased that our reunited congregation has called its very first Minister, The Reverend Dr. Randy Partain. While embracing a 150-year history, we are committed to sustaining and growing a new congregation with Reverend Randy.

While it was necessary to close our building for a brief time, we are able to enjoy hybrid worship services (both in-person and virtually) and other activities, while our covenant keeps members safe and comfortable.

Because of your stewardship commitments our 2021-2022 goal of \$475,000 was met. Last May, the congregation approved a budget with expenditures of \$662,767, income of \$632,805 and a deficit of \$29,961. Loans forgiven through the federal government's Payroll Protection Plan provided significant support. During the pandemic we maintained our staffing at pre-COVID levels without decreasing compensation. By drawing about \$66,000 from our reserves we balanced the budget.

Typically, we rely on the unrestricted reserve to balance our budget, but a significant annual draw down can't be sustained. We each need to assess our financial commitment to UUCC and increase it if possible. Our pledge income covers only 2/3 of our expenses. This percentage needs to increase. As in any community, those who are better off need to increase their financial commitment to compensate for those who can't.
