This covenant group creates space to support each other in doing the personal and congregational work to manifest the Beloved Community that welcomes everyone. This group meets on third Mondays from 7-9pm.

#### **Cancer Survivor Support Group**

This group is for those who have had a diagnosis of cancer, with or without treatment, and their partners. The meetings will start with some kind of structured discussion from a list of topics which have been co-created by the group. The goal of the group is to offer a supportive, confidential community during treatment and recovery. This group will meet monthly at a mutually agreed upon time beginning in September 2024.
