# Why Participate in the Auction?

The Annual Auction is important to the Unitarian Universalist Congregation of Cleveland for many reasons, including:

- **Communal Gathering:** The Auction event itself is an event with great food, lots of items to bid on or buy, time to hang out with your friends from UUCC, and a chance to bring interested friends to help support.
- **Community Building**: Many people donate social or learning events as auction items and you can bid on or buy entry to events that take place over the remainder of this congregation year.
- **Funding Our Congregation:** Did you know that the Auction is listed in the UUCC Annual Budget as a significant source of income that supports our programs and operations? This year the amount we hope to raise is \$10,000.

Please **BID GENEROUSLY**! This is a key fundraiser that benefits all of us! Not only are you buying items, services, food, getaways and gatherings at very fair prices, your dollars go directly to the Congregation.

# **Auction Activities:**

#### Silent Auction

Write your bid number and bid on the sheet. Your bid must raise the prior bid by the "minimum raise" amount noted.\* (See next paragraph.) Highest bid(s) win! Basically this includes any physical items, service items and events. At checkout, you will receive the item or a certificate for the event, service, or experience.

\*In the case of multiple offerings of one item, a bid raise may not be necessary. For example, if a service is offered to the 3 highest bidders, bidders 2 & 3 can bid the same amount as bidder 1, however, the 4th bidder must raise the bid (thereby knocking bidder 3 off the list, because bidders 1 & 2 got there first.) Sound complicated? When in doubt, just raise the bid! Auction Committee members will be available for questions, and will scrutinize the bid sheets for fairness.

#### Fixed Price

These are usually events or some physical items for multiple people offered at a fixed-price. Sign-up is on a first-come, first-served basis. Write your bidder number on the list to reserve a place for yourself! These items or events are open to everyone until the limit is reached. At checkout you will receive the item or a certificate with all the pertinent information about the event.

# **Bid and Bump Boards**

Think of the Bid and Bump Boards as a game of strategy, timing, and a little bit of luck! Here's the scoop:

- 1. **Pick your Event** Each event up for bid is listed with a bid sheet.
- 2. **Place Your Bid** Write down your bidder number and the amount you're willing to pay.
- 3. **Check Back Often** Someone else might outbid you! You can swoop back in and raise your bid to stay on top.
- 4. **Winning Time** When the auction closes, the highest bid wins the item.

It's simple, fun, and a bit competitive!

## Raffle

Tickets will be for sale 5:30-7:00. 1 ticket for \$1, 6 tickets for \$5. \$20 gets you an arm's or leg's length of tickets (does not have to be your arm or leg). Each Raffle item will have a bag for your tickets.

#### Wine Grab

Try your luck with our fun Wine Grab! For just \$20, you'll draw a playing card and take home the bottle of wine that matches your card. Every card wins – and every bottle is a surprise, valued between **\$15** and **\$75**. Which will you walk away with, red, white, or sparkling treat? Good luck!

#### Beer Pull

Take your pick in our hidden beer pull! For just \$5, you'll pull a mystery bottle or can of beer from our stash. Every pull wins, and the variety is wide—local craft brews, seasonal favorites, crisp lagers, hoppy IPAs, smooth stouts, and maybe even a hard cider or two. Whether you're into light and refreshing or bold and adventurous, there's something for everyone. Cheers!

At the conclusion of the entertainment, come to Fellowship Hall, check the winning bidder display board to see if you won! If you're a winner, go to the checkout table to pay your invoice and collect your winnings.
